AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF BOOME, MORTH CAROLINA

WHEREAS, the Town Council has been petitioned under G.S. 160-31, as amended, to annex the area described herein; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has by resolution directed the Town Clerk to investigate the sufficiency of said petition; and

WHEREAS, the Town Clerk has certified the sufficiency of said petition and a public hearing on the question of this annexation was held at the Council Chambers at 635 Blowing Rock Road at 6:30 p.m. on the 27th day of October, 1988, after due notice by publication on the 14th day of October, 1988; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council does hereby find as a fact that said petition meets the requirements of G.S. 160A-31, as amended;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Boone, North Carolina:

Section 1. By virtue of the authority granted by G.S. 160A-31, as amended, the following described territory, is hereby annexed and made part of the Town of Boone as of the 27th day of October, 1988.

Section 2. Upon and after the 27th day of October, 1988, the above described territory and its citizens and property shall be subject to all debts, laws, ordinances and regulations in force in the Town of Boone and shall be entitled to the same privileges and benefits as other parts of the Town of Boone. Said territory shall be subject to municipal taxes according to 6.5. 160A-58.10.

Section 3. The Mayor of the Town of Boone shall cause to be recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Watauga County, and in the office of the Secretary of State at Raleigh, North Carolina, an accurate map of the annexed territory, described in Section 1 hereof, together with a duly certified copy of this ordinance.
